- Still waiting on appointments for squad decals and updating new squad with equipment.
- Consensus for Police Chief to use city's radio while on duty with Becker County Sheriffs Department. (not for boat/water use)
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Motion Johnson, second Soyring to approve oil change and brake repairs to the squad. Motion carried. (5-0)

**Public Works:**

- Liquor store is scheduled for outside maintenance in 2025.
- Alley's will be graded and graveled this summer.

Motion Annette, second Molacek to approve Otter Tail Power Easement Agreement at 901 First Ave (Fire Hall) Motion carried. (5-0)

**Clerk:**

- A letter was received from Otter Tail Power regarding lowering electricity rates at the Event Center due to low usage.
- The city will receive Small Cities Transportation assistance in the amount of \$8,490. This money will be used towards resurfacing city streets in 2026.
